Dear Health Care Provider:

In an effort to make prescription medicines more accessible and more affordable for our most vulnerable citizens, the state of Michigan and Governor Jennifer M. Granholm are proud to present the MiRx Card. With the use of this new prescription drug discount card, uninsured and underinsured Michigan residents will be able to get their prescription medication for less money at participating pharmacies. The MiRx Card is designed only for Michigan residents who do not have prescription drug coverage.

Please help us get the MiRx Card into the hands of the people who need it the most – uninsured and underinsured Michigan residents. Beneficiaries of the MiRx Card program will save as much as 20 percent off the retail prices they would normally pay as a cash customer. You can have a positive impact on the health of your fellow citizens by prominently displaying these informative brochures at your place of business.

The MiRx Card program is free. There is no cost for the card. There is no cost to enroll in the program. And, the MiRx Card is easy to use. MiRx Card holders will take their prescription and their MiRx card to their local participating pharmacy. The pharmacist will fill the prescription and charge the MiRx discounted price.

There is no age limit to participate in the MiRx Card program. When individuals fill out the application, they should include all eligible members of their family or household. Once your application is completed and processed, eligible applicants will receive their own MiRx card in the mail within two weeks along with a list of participating pharmacies in their area.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a resident of the state of Michigan
- Have no other prescription drug coverage
- Have an income level at or below the state’s median income level
